## LA TIERRA DE LOS INCAS

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### Turismo Convencional > IQUITOS

Iquitos founded in 1600, is the capital of the department of Loreto and is located at the north-eastern region of Peru. Its climate is tropical, warm and humid, with a temperature averaging 28 degrees Centigrade.

The city lies on the banks of an Amazonas River branch and is surrounded by rivers and small channels. Nearby, is the Amazonas River which is navigated by different types of boats offering a variety of excursions while enjoying nature in its wildest status.

#### **PAT 0162 - ENCHANTMENTS OF THE AMAZON**

**(3 Days / 2 Nights - 1 night in the jungle 1 night in the city)**

##### **Day 1: IQUITOS / LODGE**

Transfer to the airport to board the flight to Iquitos. Upon arrival, reception and transfer to the pier to take a boat called "pacamari" and navigate along the Amazonas for about 1 ½ hours until reaching the lodging facilities. Check-in at the lodge, lunch and take a walk through the jungle to visit an Indian tribe. Dinner and take a night ride in a canoe.

##### **Day 2: LODGE / IQUITOS**

Get up very early in the morning and participate on a bird watching tour. Breakfast and, at the convened time, return to the city of Iquitos. Transfer to the hotel for check-in. Tour Quistococha.

##### **Day 3: IQUITOS....**

Breakfast in the hotel.

Transfer to the airport to board the flight back to Lima.
