Iquitos founded in 1600, is the capital of the department of Loreto and is located at the north-eastern region of Peru. Its climate is tropical, warm and humid, with a temperature averaging 28 degrees Centigrade.

The city lies on the banks of an Amazonas River branch and is surrounded by rivers and small channels. Nearby, is the Amazonas River which is navigated by different types of boats offering a variety of excursions while enjoying nature in its wildest status.

PAT 0163 - BASIC EXPLORER PROGRAM (3 days/2 nights) LODGE with air conditioning. (EXPLORER)

Day 1: IQUITOS LODGE IN THE JUNGLE

Upon arrival, reception, brief city tour and transfer to the port to board a boat and navigate the impressive and majestic Amazon River, the mightiest river in the world, lodging in a Cabin hut and began the adventure.

In the afternoon, excursion to the primary jungle. Dinner. At night, you could hear the natural sounds of the amazon region

Day 2: LODGE IN THE JUNGLE

In the morning excursion by boat to watch the Pink Dolphins River or visit a tribal group from the peruvian Amazonic and share to be in the habit and cultural interpretation, craftsmanship or demonstration Hunting with blowpipe or arc and arrow. In the evening free time to enjoy the environs of the lodge.

Day 3: LODGE IN THE JUNGLE - IQUITOS

In the morning long walk or stroll in boat like taking leave of this beautiful region. To the oportune hour transfer until the airport of Iquitos to approach the return flight.
