Turismo Convencional > CHICLAYO

Chiclayo is the capital of the Department of Lambayeque and is located in the northern coast of Peru at 22 meters of altitude. It was founded in 1553 and with its warm and pleasurable weather is a center of great commercial activity.

Chiclayo is the cradle of the Lord of Sipan who was a dignitary and priest in the Valley of Lambayeque. The discovery of The Lord of Sipans' tomb became the most important one of the last times. It has been compared with that of the tomb of the Maya Prince Pajal, and in a lesser degree with the discovery of the tomb of the Pharaon TutanKamon.

The city of Chiclayo is closely related to Peruvian Folk Medicine practiced by Witches and Healers.

PAT 0188 -CHICLAYO AND SIPAN (3 Days / 2 Nights)

Day 1: CHICLAYO

Transfer to the airport or bus station to travel to Chiclayo. Upon arrival, reception and transfer to the hotel for lodging accommodations.

Day 2: HUACA RAJADA EXCURSION / SIPAN

Continental breakfast in the hotel, and begin the excursion to visit the complex of Huaca Rajada, Sipan and the Bruning National Archeological Museum of Lambayeque.

Day 3: TUCUME EXCURSION / BACK TO LIMA

Continental breakfast in the hotel and visit the archeological complex of Tucume located 35 kilometers away from Chiclayo, which was the Capital of the Lambayeque Kingdom. It includes 26 pyramids located on the lower part of the Valley of the Milk River around the Purgatorio Mountain. At the convenient time, transfer to the airport or to the bus station to return to Lima.
