## LA TIERRA DE LOS INCAS

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### Turismo Convencional > AREQUIPA

Founded on August 15, 1540, Arequipa is the second largest and most important city of Peru and is located in the southern part of the country at 2,230 meters of altitude. Its weather is dry and mild during the day and cool during the night allowing for sunny days most of the year. Arequipa is also known, as "the white city" because of its buildings made of a white volcanic stone called "sillar". This architecture had a great Spanish influence during the colonial times and remains until these days. The city is surrounded by beautiful countryside called "La Campiña" with picturesque places, some of which offer the opportunity to enjoy trekking, cycling, river rafting, etc.

#### **PAT AQP 017 TORO MUERTO. (Full Day)**

We leave from 07:00 to the Majes Valley, visit famous Toro Muerto petroglyphs. There are five kilometers of volcanic rocks with anthropomorphic and zoomorphic figures and other enigmatic ones, with an antiquity of 800 years approx.; town of Corire, the Valley of Majes with their enormous amount of cultures of rice, beans and fruit tree.

On the place called next to the Majes River (Colca) can be tasted the delicious SHRIMPS. In the evening, return to Arequipa. (In route we will appreciate the irrigation of Pampas of Majes). 15:30 p.m. approx Arrival to Arequipa.
