MANU – It is the most important natural destination in the world.

Manu offers the greatest quantity and diversity of animals and plants in the world. No other destination in Peru or beyond can compare. Nowhere else can you enjoy a superbly intact transect of tropical habitats from Andean grasslands and cloud forests down to foothill and lowland forests. Manu boasts the highest bird, mammal, and plant diversity of any park on Earth, including 1,000 of the world's 9,700 bird species, 200 species of mammals, and 15,000 species of flowering plants. The most photogenic spectacles are frolicking Giant Otters, 1,000 parrots and macaws at a riverbank clay lick, dancing Cocks-of-the-Rock, habituated monkeys, and huge Lowland Tapirs at a forest clay lick. One of our lodges, Manu Wildlife Center, currently offers the world's finest viewing of this elusive animal, which elsewhere is harder to see even than the Jaguar, which also is a frequent sight in Manu.

PAT EC 197 - MANU NATIONAL PARK (8 Days / 7 Nights)

Circuit: Scenic
Location: Madre de Dios - Manu
Level: Moderate
Duration: 8 days/ 7 nights
Operation: From April To November
Weather: Tropical / humid

Day 1: CUSCO / SALVACION

Early morning (5:30 am aprox) our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel to head toward the Amazonia. Along the way we will pass by Huambutio to climb up to Huancarani (4,100 meters) After that, descend to the typical colonial town of Paucartambo (3,600 meters), passing by the Ajanaaco gorge (3,900 meters), and by Tres Cruces.

Later we will descend toward the jungle where we will observe the contrast of nature between the mountain range and the grounds of the jungle. Includes box lunch. Later we will continue towards Boca Manu (Confluence of Madre de Dios and Manu Rivers), where we will set camp and dinner. (L. D.)

Day 2: SALVACIÓN / BOCA MANU

After the breakfast we will take the mobility to return again to the edge of the river and to initiate our trip through descending for the High Madre de Dios river, where we will be able to appreciate the locality of Diamante (settlement of the tribe of the Piros). Box Lunch included. Then we will continue toward the locality of Boca Manu (Confluence of Madre de Dios and Manu rivers), where we will camp. (B.L.D.)



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Day 3: BOCA MANU/COCHA SALVADOR

Breakfast at campsite and departure by boat, riding the Manu River, where we will begin to enjoy, the exuberant local Flora and Fauna. Box lunch included. At noon we enter Manu Park's National Reserve through the control gate. A great opportunity to refresh ourselves in the river (no danger). Later we will continue our journey up river until reaching Cocha Salvador (a lagoon that used to be the bed of the river). Arrival, dinner and camp. (B.L.D)

Day 4: COCHA SALVADOR/OTORONGO / SALVADOR

Stroll at down through the jungle along established passages (aprox. 2 hours stroll). Return to camp to have breakfast. Those who wish to continue investigating can do it through several established passages in the area or ride along the river in the typical "Piraguas" and take a dip in the water. Lunch and dinner included. We ride the river in canoes, moving along with the engine off to be able to appreciate and hear the sound the jungle, reaching Cocha Otorongo. Later we stroll through the jungle along an established path that leads to Cocha Salvador. (B.L.D).

Day 5: COCHA SALVADOR / BOCA MANU

All day free in the area. The community of Boca Manu, a small native civilization, survives on it agricultural production. Includes all food and lodging. (B.L.D)

Day 6: BOCA MANU

After breakfast at campsite, we continue traveling by boat to return to the starting point at Amazonia, where the lodge is located.

Day 7: BOCA MANU / SALVADOR

Breakfast and transfer to the river shore to cross by boat until reaching Atalaya and continue the trip towards Cusco. Box lunch included. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. (DAC).

Day 8: SALVADOR / CUSCO

Breakfast and transfer to the river shore to cross by boat until Atalaya and continue travel towards Cusco. Box lunch included. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. (DAC).
