The city of Ica, founded in 1563, is the capital of the Department of Ica and is located in the southern part of the Peruvian coast at approximately 300 kilometers from Lima and 456 meters of altitude.

NAZCA

PAT ICA 37 CAHUACHI CEREMONIAL CENTER

At 28 km to the northeast of the city of Nasca, this was (45 minutes in car approximately) Made up of pyramids truncate of marinated, was built by Nazcas (370 a.C. - 550 d.C.).

An opened patio of a side and an ample terrace with enclosures are distinguished roofs; in the tops of the greater temples, like in the Great Temple, were great rooms with tens of columns. Most of these pyramids they were left during century V and VI a.C.
