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### Turismo Convencional > PUNO

Puno is located in the south-eastern part of the country at 3,827 meters of altitude on the banks of the Titicaca Lake, which is the world's highest navigable lake connecting Peru and Bolivia with a particular beauty and full of mystery characteristic of this mythical place.

Puno was founded in 1668 and is known as the folkloric capital of Peru as well as the cradle of the Inca's legend. Puno's weather has two main seasons: rainy between December and April and dry between May and September, it is mild during the day and cold at night.

### PAT PUN 020 PUNO / LA PAZ

At 08:00 hrs starts the trip to La Paz. On the way, we will stop in the city of Copacabana (at around 11:00 hrs.) where we can see the Virgin of Copacabana. At 14:30 hrs, we will board the aliscafo which will take us to the Sun and The Moon Islands, continuing to Huatajata where the bus will pick you up to travel to La Paz.
