PAT TK 133 - INCA TRAIL - MACHU PICCHU (4 Days / 3 Nights)

Circuit :	Scenic and archeological
Activity :	Trekking
Location :	Vilcabamba Chain – Cusco
Level :	It requires of great physical effort
Length:	39.5 kilometers
Time:	4 days (Optional Overnight in Aguas Calientes)
High Maximum:	Warmiwañusca pass at 4,250 meters of altitude
Season Recommended:	April to November
Weather:	Cold, dry, mild and humid.

Few adventure tours are as spectacular as the Inca Trail tour that is considered among the most important trekkings in the world, besides being the most interesting in South America.

NOTE: The camps that are indicated here can have variations in their location by technical questions, and /or according to the supply and demand with the purpose of a better service.

Day 1: CUSCO / PISCACUCHU / LLULLUCHAPAMPA

Transfer from the train station or by vehicle with destiny to starting point of the great adventure "the Inca Trail" that developed between forests of eucalyptus and beautiful landscapes that alone some has the privilege to enjoy next to impressive archaeological remains. The first remains that are seen are Q'ente, Pulpituyoc, Patallacta, etc. (L. D.)

Day 2: LLULLUCHAPAMPA / QHAQUICOCHA

Breakfast. This day can be considered the most hard, therefore will have to conquer the 4,250 m. s. n. m. of the summit of Huarmi Wañusqa the step but high, since where will have a beautiful panorama appreciating Wayllabamba aside and on the other side Runcuraccay, that is where continue walking to the valley of the Pacaymayu river, place in which the archaeological remains are found in Runcuracay, Ritual of themselves continuous to the second summit of 3950 msnm. Descending is passed and visits Sayaqmarca, constituted by narrow alleys, liturgical sources, etc. Until arriving at Chaquicocha, where the second camp will be done. (B. L. D.)

Day 3: CHAQUICOCHA / WIÑAWAYNA.

Breakfast. This is the longest portion of the trail, but also the most interesting because of the impressive archeological locations such as Runcuracay (security control post and ritual station), Sayaqmarca, consisting of small narrow streets, religious fountains,

backyard and a surrounding protection wall and finally reaching Puyupatamarca where we will set up the camp. (B. L. D.)

Day 4: WIÑAY WAYNA / MACHU PICCHU

This is the last carried out for the eyebrow of forest in which is found Intipunco (Door of the Sun) privileged place where we will appreciate the impressive monument of MACHU PICCHU and achieved a visual ecstasy. Guided excursion to the spectacular Sacred City of the Incas "Machu Picchu", located strategically in the summit of a full Mountain of vegetation, built all in stone where they are appreciated: palaces, temples, plazas, terraces, houses, granaries, etc. After the traveled through transfer to Aguas Calientes town. (Lunch by its account) Back to Cusco. (B.)

OPTIONAL:

One night additional in Aguas Calientes town. (town where you can find a thermal bath and it is located inside the archaeological center

Day 5: MACHU PICCHU / CUSCO.

Breakfast. Day free to stroll for the outskirts, to visit the thermal baths. We will be able to enjoy a second visit to the archaeological center and/or to climb to the Huayna Picchu or to visit the Inca bridge. All your incomes and mobility of this day are paid by yourself. Back to Cusco. Reception in the station and transfer to the hotel. (B)

THE PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Private transportation to the starting point of the trek.
- Train services: First class (A & B), Tourist class (C).
- Highly trained Tour Guides doing the Inca trail.
- Cooker, assistants, etc.
- Carriers (they carry: provisions, tents and other heavy things).
- Carriers will carry the passenger's baggages (A), (B).
In C, the client takes its personal baggages.
- Ticket for Machu Picchu.
- Double tents for the customer.
- A cooker tent, a dining room, a bathroom tent.
- First-aid kit.
- A bus to take you back from Machu Picchu to the station.
- Complete meals during the whole walk: 3B, 3L (B.L.), 3D
and a glass of wine or Champagne in the dinner for the program (A).
- Transfer from the San Pedro station / Hotel (A) - (B) - (C).
- A-B-C, means the categories in the service quality
B= Breakfast - L=Lunch - D=Dinner
